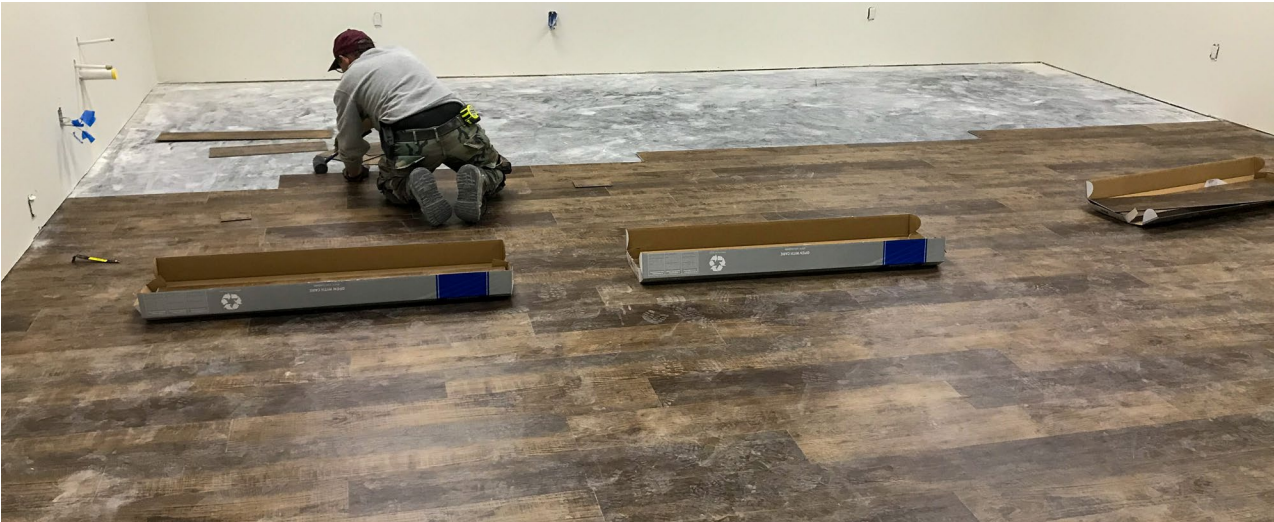
Before You Start

Make sure you have the right tools and importantly all of the appropriate protective equipment before starting.



Dust from the removal of old floors, glues and sealants can be harmful so make sure you have plenty of personal protective equipment including glasses, ear protection, face mask and gloves where required.

Some floors may require specialised equipment but most floors can be laid if you have a method of cutting and accurately measuring the materials. Before you start make sure you read the complete installation process to anticipate what tools you may need. The Right Floors team can also guide you through the process and recommend tools for the job.



01. Preparing Your Underfloors



Make sure your existing flooring is flat and suitable for the product you have chosen.

Many vinyl or laminate floors can be installed straight over the top of existing hard floors but old carpet will need to be removed and you will need to check the under floor is flat, sturdy and free from anything that may obstruct or interfere with the adhesives used. If you are going over the top of existing hardwood timber flooring they may need to be sanded down, especially at the joints to make sure that the new floors sit flat.

Talk to the Right Floors team about your existing flooring as to whether they believe it is suitable for your project.

02. Lay The Floors



Laying your new floors will probably take longer than expected.

It can be slow work which is not easy on your body, it is a good idea to allow yourself extra time to make sure that you can complete the job properly.

If you are using timber products the boards may also need time to acclimatize once they arrive. Timber products will shrink and expand in different environments and different levels of humidity, it is a good idea to open the cartons and let them rest for a few days before you begin.

Take your time and install products in accordance with the product guide, remember the old saying of measure twice and cut once. This is especially important in tricky areas between rooms and up against walls where a lot of product waste can occur.



03. Post-Install and maintenance

Now that your flooring is down take some time to sit back and admire your handiwork

Make sure that you follow any instructions from the product manufacturer and allow any glues and sealants to dry before walking on or moving furniture back into your fresh new room.

Make sure that when you do move all of your furniture back in you don't drag it across your brand new floors and scratch them. Lift smaller items, or use a movers blanket to move heavier items.

Now that you are a flooring expert you can start thinking about your next project.



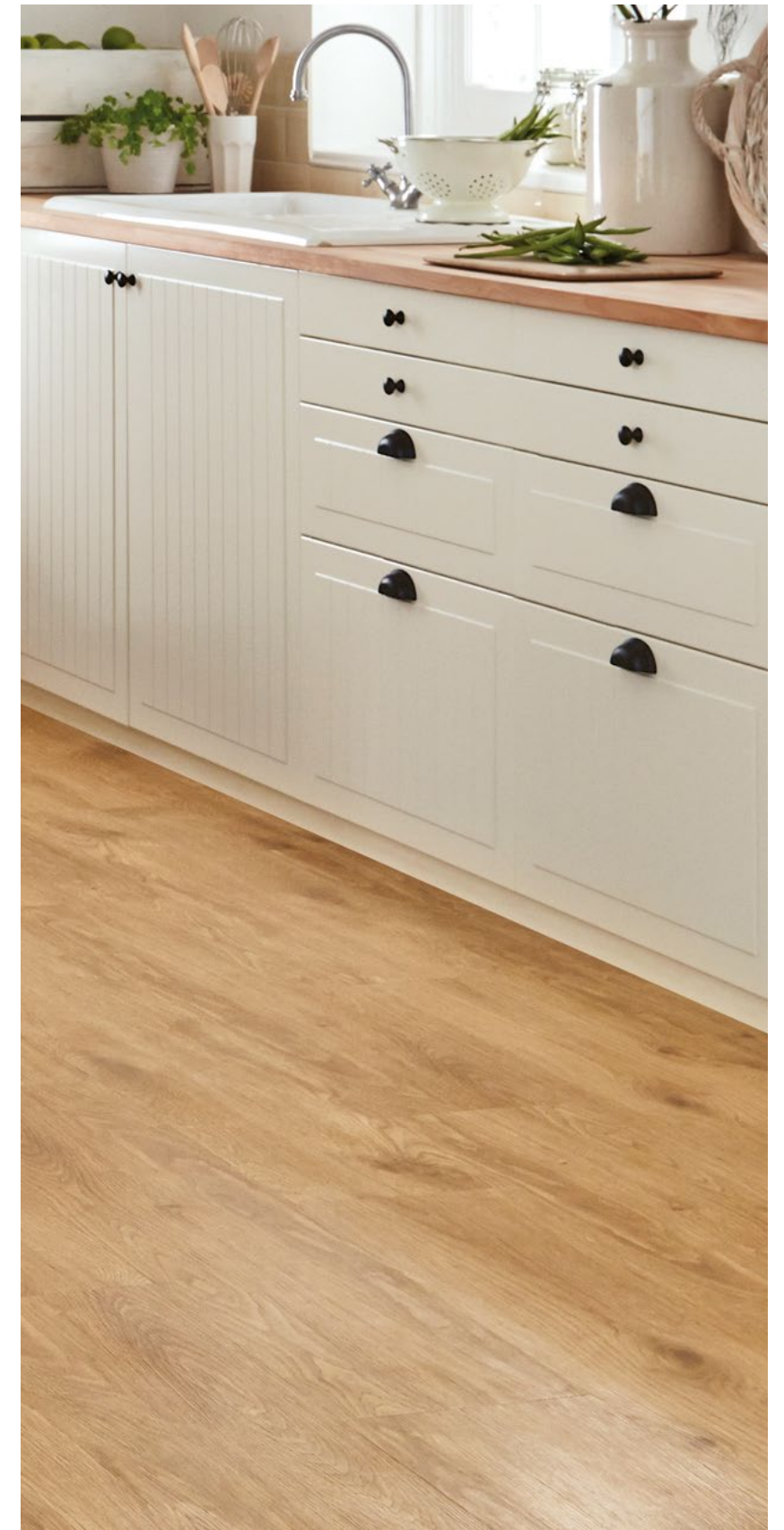

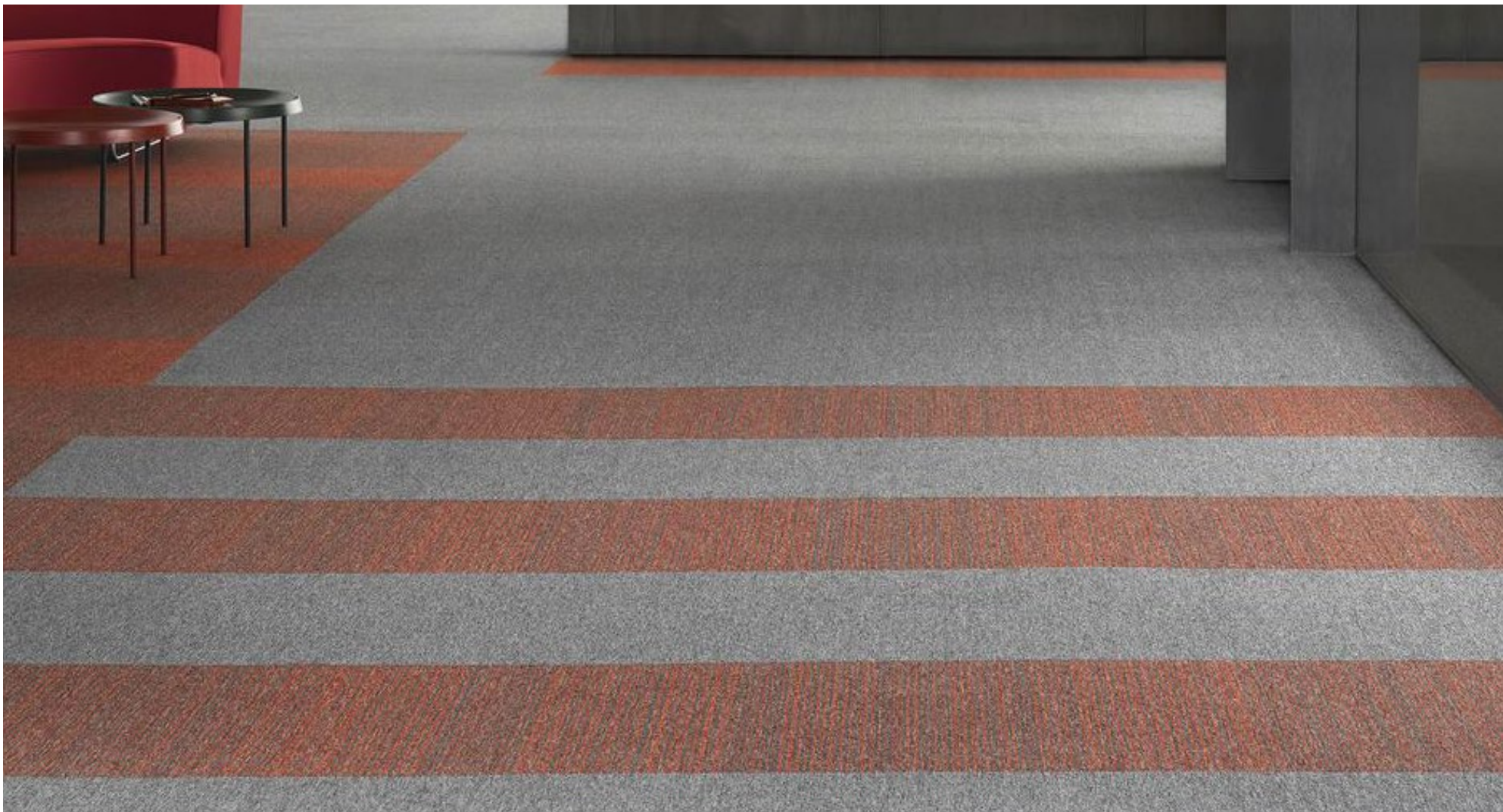

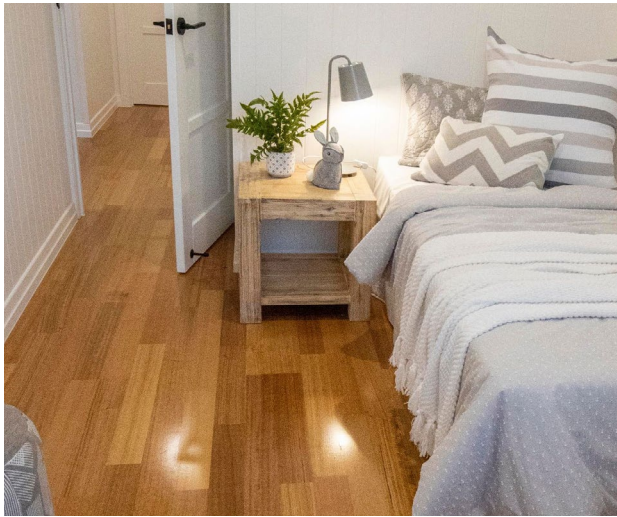
