STAIN REMOVAL

1 SCOOP

Scoop up as much of the spill as possible, vacuuming up any dry particles.

2 PREP

Prep your cleaning solution of:

- Detergent - mix 1/4 teaspoon mild liquid dish soap with one cup of warm water.

3 APPLY & BLOT

Apply the cleaning solution to area and **BLOT** with a clean white cloth until the stain stops transferring to the cloth. **DO NOT RUB** the stain as it can damage the carpet.

4 RINSE

Rinse with cold water and blot with a clean white cloth until all of the cleaning solution is removed from the carpet.

5 DRY

Dry using layers of white paper towel laid on the site and weighted down (with a glass or other non-staining object) to absorb all the moisture.
